**“LANGUAGE AND TRANSLATION IN THE CONTEXT OF INTERCULTURAL
COMMUNICATION: RELEVANT ISSUES AND CONTEMPORARY PERSPECTIVES”**

The conference will be held **in a hybrid format (using remote technologies) from April 21-22, 2023**. Graduates, postgraduates, young scientists (without an academic degree) and undergraduates of 2-4 year of studies are invited to participate in the conference.

Within the framework of the conference the **XIV International Academic Talks “Philology, intercultural communication and translation in the XXI century”** with the participation of the representatives of the academic community of Russian and foreign universities will be held as part of the International Multilingual Virtual University Project “World without Borders” of the International Institute of Interdisciplinary Education and Ibero-American Studies of SFedU.

The conference will provide an opportunity to discuss, evaluate and share the results of the scientific research of the students and young scientists, to form international research groups in an interdisciplinary scientific space and to exchange experience and opinions on issues of modern science.

The working language of the conference is Russian.

In the English-language section "Languages, Cultures, and Societies: Current Issues and Research Trends" the reports are to be delivered **in English**.

For publication it is necessary to send the **Abstracts/articles** (requirements in Appendix 2) on the subject of the report **by May 20, 2023**.

Appendix 2

Requirements for the design of Report materials

We recommend accompanying the report with a presentation prepared in the PowerPoint program.

There are three possible publication options:

- 1) Abstracts of the conference participants under the guidance of the scientific supervisor
- 2) Abstracts of the conference participant in co-authorship with the scientific supervisor (the full names of the authors are indicated in the abstract header without specifying the supervisor)
- 3) The article of the conference participant in co-authorship with the supervisor (the full names of the authors are indicated in the abstract header without specifying the supervisor)

The volume of the abstracts of the report is 1-3 pages. The volume of the article is up to 6 pages.

Document format: doc. Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, single line spacing, width alignment. Mirror margins: top/ bottom – 2 cm, inside 1.5 cm, outside 2 cm, indent (paragraph) – 1.25 cm. Pages are not numbered, hyphenation is prohibited.

Text alignment using spaces and tabs is not allowed.

Article title: Times New Roman, 14 pt. bold, centered.

The initials and surname of the author, affiliation, degree of study (bachelor's student, master's student, postgraduate student), position (for young scientists) and country (14 pt., left alignment), as well as information about the supervisor (young scientists can be published without the indication of the supervisor) are indicated under the title.

Tables: Times New Roman, 12 pt, with single line spacing. Tables are numbered and must have headings (for example: Table 1. Age composition of dialect speakers).

Notes and footnotes are not allowed.

Examples: Times New Roman, 12 pt, width alignment, indent – 1.25 cm, separated from the previous and subsequent text by one empty line.

Quotes: quotes up to 4 lines are drawn up inside the text in quotation marks (« »). Quotations with more than 4 lines are aligned in width, with an indent of 1.25 cm, and are separated from the previous and subsequent text by one empty line. In this case, the quote is not enclosed in quotation marks, the size is reduced to 11 pt.

All references to sources and used literature are given in the text of the article in square brackets after the quotation or the example. First, the author's surname is indicated, and then a comma, for example, separates the year of publication [Gonzalez García, 2008, p.12]. References to literature and sources (if available) are given at the end of the article in alphabetical order (starting with Russian-language sources) under the title “SOURCES AND LITERATURE” (numbered after compiling the list manually, without using automatic formatting, the number format is “digit + dot”, for example, 1., 2., etc.).

Abstract (250-300 characters): size 12 pt., left alignment.

The author(s) and scientific supervisor of the published work are responsible for the content (accuracy of the cited quotations, reliability of facts, names, titles, statistical data and other information), as well as for the correctness of the citation. Incorrect quoting is not allowed. All abstracts and articles will be checked for anti-plagiarism.

The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject materials for publication or return them for revision if the article does not meet the requirements (in terms of subject matter, scientific level,

novelty, as well as the formal side). Abstracts and articles sent to the author for revision are sent back in correct form as soon as possible.

The file name must match the name and surname of the conference participant (for example, Ivanov_Vasiliy.doc). The subject of the message must contain the name and surname of the participant with the mandatory indication – “Conference-2023”.

Requirements for the design of the bibliographic list

(in accordance with the requirements of GOST 7.1-2003 “System of standards for informatisation, library and publishing. Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. Requirements and rules of compilation”.)

A book under the author's last name

The description of the book begins with the surname of the author, if the book has no more than three authors.
